DONATE MEDICATIONS:

- Antifungal Medication (topical and oral)
- Children's Antifungal Medication
- Anticonvulsants e.g. phenytoin, carbamazepine
- Minor tranquilizers e.g. diazepam
- Gastrointestinal meds, e.g. Ranitidine antacids
- Antibiotics: (Metronidazole- doxycycline; Bactrim (substitute)- ciprofloxacin/ ofloxacin; Amoxicillin- entromycin; Cloxacillin-suspensions for child)
- Asthma medications: Salbutamol inhalers and tablets, Becotide inhalers (or substitute)
- Analgesics (Diclofenac, Ibuprofen, Cetamol, panadol (or substitute)
- Constipation and diarrhea medication
- Re-hydration salts or substitutes for vomiting and diarrhea in children
- Acne medication (any dosage form)
- Anthelmintics (worm) e.g. Albendazole or substitute
- Vitamins and minerals
- Medication for cold/ cough/ allergies/ sinus/ sore throat
- Vaginal suppositories for bacterial vaginosis, candidiasis, infection, trichomoniasis, herpes
- Diabetes medication e.g. metformin 7 glyburide and chloro
- Creams and ointments, antihistamines, steroids etc. burn treatment c reams ointments, local antibiotics
- Hypertension/heart: Digoxin (Lanoxin)- methyl dopa; HCTZ (hydro)- aspirin; Enalapril-nifedipine/nifedipine; Furosemide-captopril; Slow (potassium chloride)
- Varicose veins medication
- Eye drops- Visine, antibiotics
- Local anesthetic
- Other
