# PAST, PRESENT, FUTURE



**1999**

Leonardo D. Gilbert, a missionary with a unique educational background in science and religion, had a dream to help those lacking proper medical care to obtain access to treatment.

Engaged with co-founder Lloyd Harris and A.A. Walker in Jamaica, he was determined to make this dream a reality. Thus, the International American Medical Mission was formed in mental conception.

**2002**

IAMM lead multi-year missions in Kingston, Jamaica.

**2004-2008**

Multiple parishes in Jamaica

**2010**

A massive earthquake hits Port Au Prince, Haiti in January. IAMM plans a mission and charters a plane to Haiti in February, bringing physicians and nurses, medication, supplies, team members, and hope to Haiti.

**2011**

IAMM serves in Jimani (Santo Domingo)

**2013**

IAMM serves in Leogane, Haiti; Kingston, Jamaica; and collaborates with the Church of Christ Crusade in Montgomery, Alabama.

**2015**

IAMM provides missionary service in Su Malas, Haiti; Spanish Town in Jamaica; and collaborates with the Church of Christ Crusade in San Antonio, Texas.

**2018 -PRESENT**

IAMM, bringing physicians and nurses, medication, supplies, team members, and hope to the Belize, Jamaica, Dominican Republic and Puerto Rico.

**2001**

Conception becomes reality as Gilbert conducts research and secures 501c3 status for the organization with the Federal Government. Little did he know that the organization's first mission trip would take place to Jamaica would raise more than \$200,000 with 120 volunteers leading the way providing medical services for more than 1,000 patients per day when they had a capacity to serve 500.

**2003**

The IAMM team embarked on two successful mission trips to Jamaica; one in March and the another in August.

**2009**

IAMM participates in a major health initiative in Kansas City, Missouri; IAMM had its first collaboration with the National Crusade for Christ.

**2012**

IAMM completes a mission in Haiti while the nation is in turmoil and successfully delivered health care and counseling to those underserved.

**2014**

The medical mission crosses the border into the Dominican Republic to assist displaced Haitians in a multi-city mission.

**2017**

IAMM serves in St. Marc in Haiti; Portmore in Jamaica; and collaborates with the Church of Christ Crusade in Charlotte, North Carolina.
